Philip and the eunuch

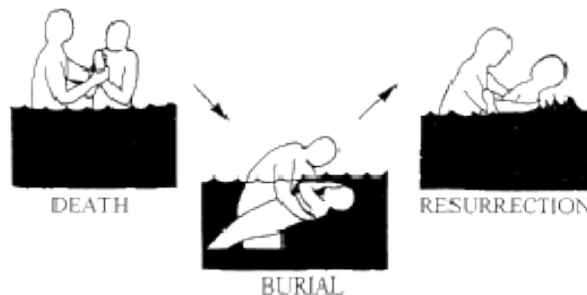


Acts 8:29-31 "Then The Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot. And Philip ran thither to him, and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest? And he said, How can I, except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him."

Verse 35-37 "Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same Scripture, and preached unto him Jesus. And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized? And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is The Son of God. And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him."

Before Philip would baptize the eunuch, he told him that first the eunuch must with all his heart.

After the eunuch told him that he believed, they both went down the water.



When someone is baptized, we see a type of the death, burial and resurrection of

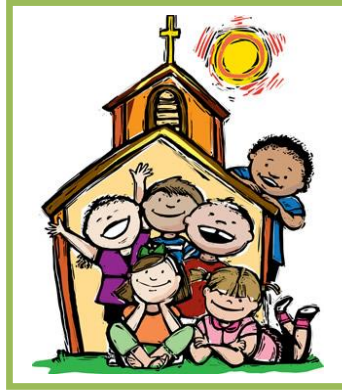

Attending Church

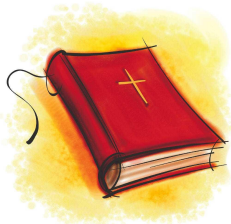


Hebrews 10:25

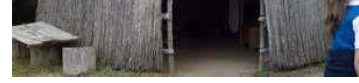

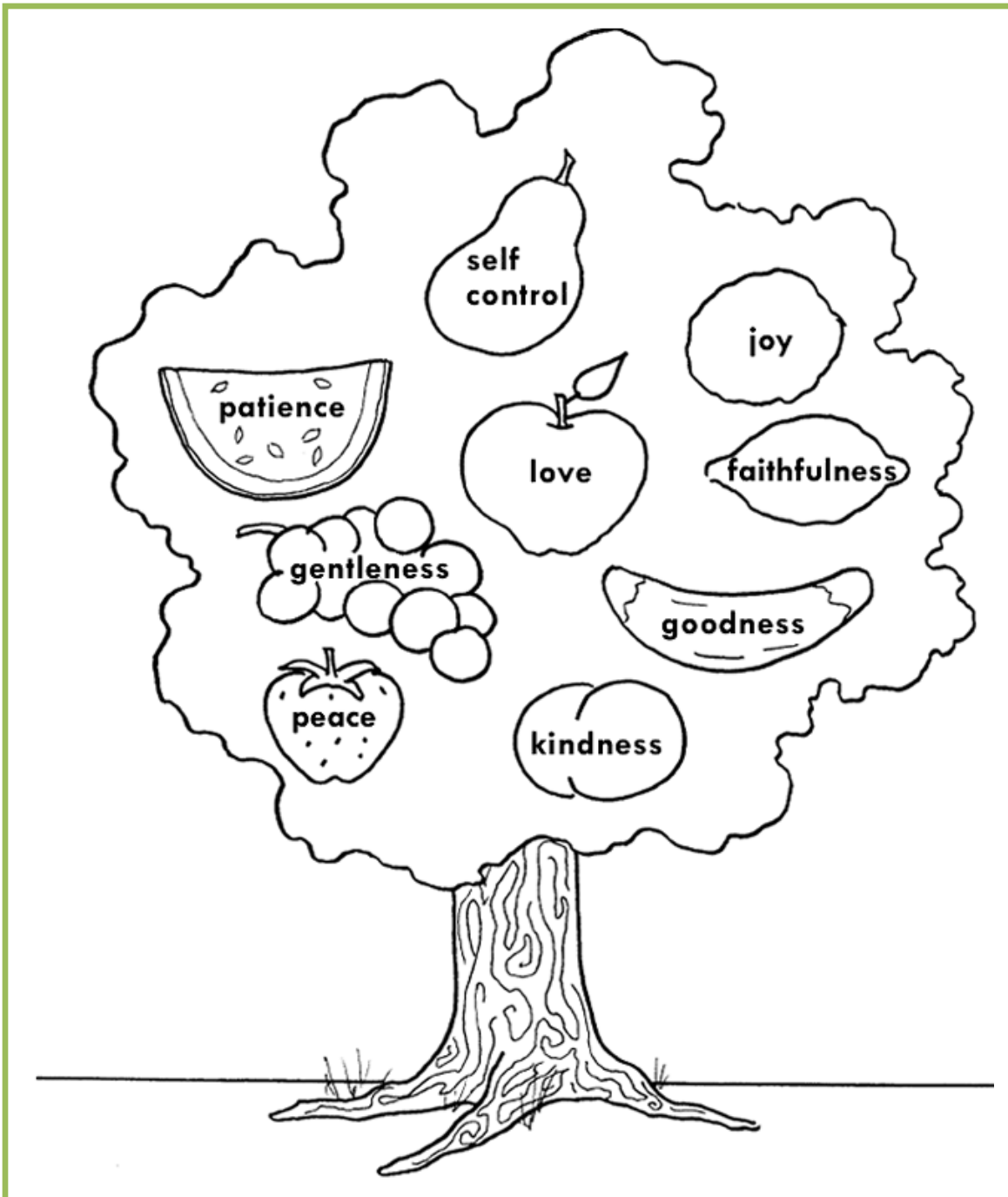
